Intern for Social Justice

Mission/Purpose: to support the parish in our Christian obligation to have social justice become an integral part of our faith

Primary skills developed: comprehensive background in social justice ministry and advocacy, administration, event planning, leadership skills, working with diverse populations

Supervised by: Campus Minister for Social Justice

Tasks/responsibilities:

- The social justice intern (SJI) will facilitate, with the support of the campus minister, the social justice ministry lead team. The lead team is responsible for creating and implementing a strategy to integrate service and working for justice into the life of the parish. The lead team consists of resident and student parishioners, with students assuming leadership roles. The lead team will plan and coordinate service opportunities, education for justice events, advocacy opportunities, and spiritual formation resources.
- The SJI will coordinate the SJM communication plan using all our means of communication (bulletin, pulpit announcement, website, Campus Catholic Community e-newsletter, and social media.) The SJI will primarily be responsible for the creation of a monthly SJM e-newsletter.
- Assist in the coordination of the Ignatian Family Teach-In in Washington, DC and participate in this event.
- Maintain the Social Justice Ministry bulletin board

Requirements/Recommendations: Previous experience with Social Justice Ministry and/or Alternative Spring Break is recommended. Interest in and experience with some aspect of social justice from a faith perspective is required.
